A Traditional method sparkling that rivals some of the top French fizz. Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. Notes of apple and citrus fruits, pepper and thyme. Complex, toasty and the perfect apéritif to any meal.

Delicate aromas of white flowers with notes of apple, pear and apricot. Seductive with a very fine mousse and brioche flavours on the palate.

### <sup>403</sup> Champagne, Bollinger, Special Cuvée Brut, 12%, France NV

A golden colour with a beautifully fine mousse. Aromatic and complex with ripe fruit and spicy aromas on the nose. Roasted apples, apple compote and peaches on the palate. Brioche and notes of fresh walnut linger on the lasting finish. A subtle combination of structure, length and vivacity. 60% Pinot Noir, 25% Chardonnay, 15% Meunier.

### Champagne, Delamotte, Blanc de Blanc, 12%, France, NV

On the nose - the luminous sweetness of tropical fruit – green mango, melon, pineapple – instantly shines. The wine immediately imposes its ample presence, full and massive.

Elegant, subtle, complex with notes of bread, ripe fruit, nuts and some creaminess. Clean citrus fruit and niscuits with a long finish.

### Champagne, Dom Perignon, Brut, 12.5%, France 2012

Complex nose combines floral (white flowers) and fruity (apricot, plum) aromas with a beautiful minty freshness and subtle smoky notes, leading to a tasty minerality. The precise and generous palate reveals a lively effervescence. Over the course of the tasting, the palate exudes aromas of ginger, tobacco and toast, leading to a tighter finish with good persistence.

# Whispering Angel, Caves d'Esclans, Sacha Lichine, 13% France, 2024

This beautiful salmon pink in colour rosé has a very pretty scent of crushed strawberries, peach, rose water and orange blossom. On the palate wonderfully dry and crisp with delicate summer berry fruits balanced by citrus zest acidity and a deliciously creamy finish.

# Château Minuty, 281 Cuvée, Cotes de Provence, 13% France, 2021

Château Minuty 281 Côtes de Provence Rosé is the estates iconic rosé style wine produced only in very small quantities and is the quintessence of Provence. Cultivated from Grenache that are on average 25 years old, with additions of Cinsault and Syrah making up the remainder of the blend, 281 is the Pantone reference number for the Royal Blue colour which cascades down the side of the bottle. The palate as great depth with wonderful mineral structure.

Well-balanced, food-friendly wine with medium body and light bright characteristic fruit flavours of apricot and peach. Aromas of exotic fruit with hints of almond and honeysuckle on the finish.

# Merlot, Domaine St. Estève, Pays d'Oc, 13.5% 8.40 11.50 22.70 33.00 France, 2023

Ruby red in colour, the nose boasts aromas of fresh red cherry and plum. On the palate the tannins are ripe and plush, complimented by flavours of juicy red fruits and liquorice. The wine has a well-balanced acidity and a smooth finish.

# 795 Corbières, Le Champ des Murailles, 14.5% 8.60 11.80 23.30 34.00 France, 2018

Juicy and peppery with cassis and black cherry flavours. This wine really punches above its weight.

# <sup>419</sup> Rioja, Capitoso, Altanza Bodegas, 13.5% 9.30 12.80 25.30 37.00 Spain, 2022

Maraschino cherry with pomegranate highlights. On the nose aromas of strawberry, red berry and liquorice. On the palate fresh, flavourful, velvety and sweet. Sweet almond finish.

# 420 Côtes du Rhône, Lunar Apogé, 13% 9.60 13.20 26.00 38.00 France, biodynamic, 2022

Biodynamic. Harvested at night to prevent oxidation and keep the freshness of the aromas and, fermented with natural yeasts. Aromas of violet and liquorice. Full bodied with redberry fruits and spices, rounded with a velvety texture. Blend of Syrah, Grenache, Mourvèdre, Cinsault.

# Cabernet Sauvignon, Kilikanoon, 14.5% Australia, 2020 10.30 14.20 28.00 41.00

Brick red in colour with deep crimson hues. Blackcurrant, cassis, tobacco leaf and subtle French oak char combine sweetly on the nose. Richly flavoured and textured, the classic cassis and leaf notes carry through confidently onto the palate, beautifully supported by fine grained natural tannins, smoky oak influences and balanced acidity.

# 423 Malbec, Domaine Bousquet, Mendoza, 14.5% 11.70 16.20 32.00 Argentina, 2023

Aged in French oak barrels for 10 months and packed with aromas of blackcurrant and raspberry with hints of figs, chocolate and tobacco. Medium-bodied with silky tannins and good acidity.

# <sup>322</sup> Chianti Rufina, Vandemmia, Selvapiana, 13% 12.40 17.20 34.00 50.00 Italy, 2023

Bright ruby red in colour with perfumes of blackberry fruit, red cherry and touch of spice. On the palate it is ripe and juicy but still fine and elegant in the Selvapiana style, with tight structure and lifted, floral finish with refreshing acidity.

# 426 Château Cantemerle, Les Allées, Bordeaux, 13% 13.30 18.50 36.70 54.00 France, 2018

Attractive nose of sweet red cherry, plum with hints of cedar and savoury notes. Full-bodied with firm tannins and concentrated fruits.

# <sup>302</sup> Pinot Noir, Domaine Chanson, Burgundy, 12.5% 14.00 19.50 38.70 57.00 France, 2022

The wine is un-fined to further extract flavour, but undergoes an extended period of ageing before release to help soften and refine the tannins in the wine, which enables a beautifully balanced palate. Red fruits and spices on the nose leads perfectly into a fruit focused palate of red cherries and blackcurrants.

# Picpoul de Pinet, Belardent, Languedoc, 13% 2024

36.00

Sourced from vineyards located on the edges of the Thau Lagoon and regarded as some of the oldest in the Mediterranean. Wine is crisp and refreshing, with zesty citrus and green apple notes.

# Chardonnay, Moulin d'Argent, Domaines Jérôme Choblet, 12.5% 2023

36.00

This 'old vine' Chardonnay is super fresh and lively with a lovely twist of lemon acidity. A beautifully unoaked and fresh which is balanced and dry. The palate is full of white peach and apple flavours and develops exotic fruits such as pineapple, banana and quince on the palate. A good structure with a fresh acidity leads into a lingering finish.

# Viognier, Solas, Laurent Miquel, Languedoc, 12.5% 2023

37.00

Well-balanced, food-friendly wine with medium body and light bright characteristic fruit flavours of apricot and peach. Aromas of exotic fruit with hints of almond and honeysuckle on the finish.

# Muscadet, Côtes de Grand Lieu Sur Lie, Clos de la Fine, Loire, 12.5% 2023

37.00

The palate is full with notes of exotic fruits with ripe grapes and stone fruits. The weight and the rich bread-like character are added by aging the wine over winter on it's lees leaving a silky mouth-feel. 100% Melon de Bourgogne.

# Sauvignon Blanc, Octavie, Touraine, 13.5% 2023

A brilliant pale golden colour with an expressive nose that combines citrus scents with notes of white flowers and mineral nuances. The palate has great depth of flavour with notes of greengage, white peach, gooseberry and flint, underpinned with a crisp acidity.

# Pouilly Fumé, Domaine Bel Air, Mauroy Gauliez, Loire, 13.5% 2024

The wine is bursting with fresh citrus notes of lemon and grapefruit, along with pear and peach and even some more tropical notes. The fresh fruit are accompanied by rich aromas of nettles and minerality with a clean and flinty finish.

# Vouvray Sec AC, Domaine Boutet Saulnier, Loire, 14% 2023

Dry silky white wine is made from a selected harvest of the ripest 100% Chenin Blanc grapes avoiding any botrytis to retain an intense and pure fruit. This Vouvray Sec is partly fermented in oak barrel to contribute a subtle vanilla character that enhances and mingles with melon and pear flavours balanced by citrus acidity.

# Sancerre, Domaine André Neveu, Calcaire, 12.5% 2023

56.00

Made from 100% Sauvignon Blanc grapes grown on the limestone slopes of Bué, this is a classic with a lovely grassy aroma and well balanced ripe flavours. Whilst exuberant to start, with citrus flavours, there is excellent balance and full sweet fruit on the finish.

# Sémillon-Sauvignon Blanc, Château Ad Francos, Bordeaux Blanc, 14.5% 2020

82.00

Made from 50% Sémillon and 50% Sauvignon Blanc grapes. Can be drunk now or in few years time. Rosemary and citrus fruit, nuances of stone fruit. The wine is delicious and juicy, displays good aromatic expression on the finish. Finish is slightly saline and lively.

# Bourgogne Aligoté, Domaine Denis Père et Fils, 12% 2023

46.00

Notes of peach, flowers, citrus zest, crushed apple and hints of almond. Palate is fruity, well-balanced with nice acidity. This wine expresses notes of pear, crunchy peach and hints of flowers, followed by hints of seeds and lemon.

# Chablis, Domaine d'Elise, Frederic Prain, 12.5% 2022

Fresh citrus and mineral notes beautifully balanced by layers of warm rich fruit. Slightly creamy on the palate with apple and lime fruits and a refreshing acidity. A typical 'old style' Chablis.

# Mâcon-Fuissé, Domaine Auvigue, 13% 2022

Rich with mineral flavours while a brief maturation in wooden cask adds spice and complexity. This superb crafted white Burgundy was picked by hand from old vines only the highest quality grapes and is carefully vinified at his cellars in Pouilly.

# Saint-Veran, Domaine Carrette, 13% 2022

58.00

Classic chardonnay that is lightly creamy, fresh and mineral. Appley nose, very juicy fruits with good intensity and length. Palate fresh with intense fruity notes of citrus, apples and pear. Creamy texture from lees ageing and lightly spiced.

# Chardonnay, Macon-Villages, Domaine de la Jobeline, 13.5% 2019

A classically proportioned Mâconnais with aromas of ripe stone fruit and a delicate white flower perfume. The palate is fresh, a vein of lemony acidity cutting through the peachy fruit. Medium-bodied and ever so moreish.

Aromas of white flowers, peach, grilled almond and lemon peel dominate on a mineral background. The attack is full and warm on the palate with a lively and greedy finish.

# Chablis, Domaine Laroche, Saint Martin, 12% 2023

Pale gold in colour. It has an intense freshness typical of the area, with ripe white fruit and white blossom aromas. On the palate, its minerality gives a lingering finish and wonderfully distinct character. 100% Chardonnay.

# Montagny 1er Cru, Bonneveaux, Olivier Leflaive, 13% 2021

Full and round on the palate with notes of minerality, spices and hazelnut. A zesty and pleasant wine. 100% Chardonnay.

# Pouilly-Fuisse, Premier Cru, Heritiers Auvigue, 13.5% 2020

Delight in a curious nose, where Mandarin orange zest dances with the essence of rose lilies, delivering vibrant freshness. The palate unfolds with orange oil, dew-kissed rose petals, fresh pear and finely grained oak, showing haut sophistication and focus. Pair with oily fish or dishes that elevate its vibrant flavours. 100% Chardonnay.

# Meursault, Les Narvaux, Vincent Girardin, 13.5% 2004

On the nose varied aromas of citrus fruits, fresh mixed flowers, peaches and crunchy plums, framed by buttery details and dried fruit and reveals itself in a rich, savory and satisfying, soft but elegantly fresh taste and played mainly on mineral tones. 100% Chardonnay.

# Saint-Aubin, 1er Cru, Dents de Chien, Olivier Leflaive, 13% 2022

109.00

Gorgeous nose of buttery lemon, orange zest, honeysuckle, vanilla and melon. The texture is crisp and refreshing, with a vanilla caramel density shot through with lime. Creaminess and oak underpin the fruit. 100% Chardonnay.

# Chassagne-Montrachet, Les Chaumees, Vincent Girardin, 13.5% 2019

134.00

Light nose with a hint of flowers and a light nuttiness, fine floral notes and acacia. A rich wine with good structure and a balanced acidity. 100% Chardonnay.

# Meursault, Les Narvaux, Yves Boyer-Martenot, 13% 2016

139.00

Nose reflects notes of hazelnut, brown butter, ripe white orchard fruit and the hallmark acacia nuances. There is excellent volume and richness to the bigger medium-bodied flavours that possess focused power and evident minerality on the youthfully austere, serious and lingering finish.

### Catarratto, Contrade Bellusa, Sicily, Organic, 12% 2023

Bright lemon in colour with grapefruit and blossom on the nose. The palate is fresh with a zesty, citrus acidity and notes of white peach, green apple, pear and a slight smoky undertone.

# Pinot Grigio, Ponte del Diavolo, 12.5% 2023

35.00

Light, bright lemon in colour with a lively, freshly cut pear and baked bread character on the nose. More aromatic and with more structure and body than previous years, it has lovely elegance on the palate with ripe pears, a touch of sherbet and a nutty note offset by the characteristic freshness of wines from Friuli.

# Sangiovese Bianco, Dropello, Tenuta Fertuna, 12% 2019

Straw yellow with light pink hues, reminiscent of its red berry soul. On the nose, flowery and delicate, with subtle hints of herbs and white fruits. On the palate, its fresh, dry, with an evident mineral structure. The wine has a gentle aftertaste with good acidity.

# Pecorino, Civitas Lunaria, 13% 2022

44.00

Bright gold in colour with an aromatic nose. A soft and pleasant wine with aromas of citrus, ripe pear, peach and orange blossom. The palate is clean and rich with a pleasing mineral complexity and a long finish.

# Gavi di Gavi, La Meirana, Broglia, 13.5% 2023

51.00

La Meirana is all about freshness and vitality, with lovely apple, citrus and mineral aromas with distinctive greengage and almond notes on the palate. Fresh and dry, this is particularly characterful Gavi from the world renowned Broglia estate. 100% Cortese.

# Sauvignon Blanc, Bodegas, Pinuaga, Organic, 12.5% 2022

36.00

Bright straw colour with tropical aromas of melon and papaya, and as it opens more subtle herbal notes. Fresh and juicy palate, with bright citric notes of white grapefruit and balanced acidity.

### Verdejo, José Pariente, Rueda, 13% 2023

42.00

Grassy and floral with good acidity making a fresh wine with a characteristic slight bitterness and oiliness. On the palate - herbal, mineral with a finish of tropical and citrus fruits. A classic example of the variety.

# Chardonnay, Xarel-lo, Xa, Xa, Xa, Can Vallès, 12.5% 2022

46.00

This easy drinking white is made of a blend of Xarel-lo (pronounced charel-lo) and Chardonnay combining fresh bright fruit and texture. It shows pleasant notes of fresh citrus, pear and apple on the nose, and on the palate gives silky velvety texture to complement the lively acidity and fresh flavours.

# Albariño, Pazo Señorans, Rias Baixas, 12.5% 2024

Aromas of nectarine, fresh figs, orange zest and white flowers. Dry, citrus flavours and a mineral-driven finish, which expands and deepens on the tail end. Balance of power and finesse.

# Verdejo, Barrel Fermented, José Pariente, Rueda, 13.5% 2021

Bright and golden yellow to the eye, it has an intense, complex nose, its aromas spicy, slightly smoky, with ripe fruit and a hint of wood. There are also notes of exotic fruits and minerals. In the mouth it is voluminous, unctuous and very elegant. Powerful, with a good acidity that ensures a long and lively passage. It presents a great balance between fruit and wood. Everything that is perceived in the nose appears again in the mouth.

# Grüner Veltliner, Wagramer Selektion, Heiderer-Mayer, 13% 2023

34.00

Notes of green apple, conference pear and pineapple combine with the classic pepperiness of Gruner Veltliner, all underpinned by a fresh and zesty acidity.

### Portugal

### Vinho Verde, Azal, AB Valley Wines, 12.5% 2021

38.00

A light and zesty white from Northwest Portugal. Has delicate floral and citrus notes on the nose. The palate is very fresh with a zingy acidity and notes of green apple, white peach, grapefruit and a hint of elderflower. 100% Azal Branco.

#### Armenia

Zorah, 'Voski', 13% 2019

64.00

This wine has generous aromas of pear, peach and apricot, with subtle nutty hints. It has a rich texture and a beautiful freshness on the palate, supported by a soft minerality. 'Voski' is made from equal portions of native varieties Voskéat and Garandmak. The grapes are planted on their own roots and are grown in an old village at 1,400 metres above sea level. The name Voskì means 'gold' in Armenian. The wine is unoaked and has a lovely intensity of perfume, great depth on the palate and lovely length.

#### India

### <sup>282</sup> J'Noon, Akluj White, 13.5% 2020

54.00

J'NOON is a joint venture between Kapil Sekhri of Fratelli wines and Jean-Charles Boisset. The name is a French take on the Urdu word 'Junoon', which means 'passion'. The wines are selected from the Fratelli vineyards in Akluj (Mahārāshtra), on the right bank of the Nira River about 170 kilometres south of Pune. The still wines come from vineyards situated at 650 metres above sea level in Garwar. The cool nights ensure the grapes retain perfume and acidity, while the sandy soils with a high rock content drain well and are low in nutrients, ensuring highly concentrated fruit. The white is a blend of 60% Chardonnay and 40% Sauvignon Blanc, made in the style of a Mâconnais wine under Jean-Charles' guidance.

This wine shows classic Chardonnay characteristics of green apple, white pear and stone fruit alongside fresher, more vibrant lime, lemongrass and herbaceous characteristics of the Sauvignon Blanc.

### South Africa

# Sauvignon Blanc, Southern Right, Walker Bay, 13.5% 2022

37.00

Wine with expressive individuality, minerality and palate complexity ahead of pure, pungent varietal aroma. A significant percentage of fruit from clay-rich soil has added an intense mid-palate structural component and addition overall complexity to this wine.

# <sup>270</sup> Chenin Blanc, Kaapzicht, Stellenbosch, 13% 2023

39.00

Rich, deep, complex nose of bruised yellow fruits, white peach, creamy and plush, showing honeyed pineapples, leesy yellow fruits. Plenty of gravitas, fruit weight, focus and textural complexity.

### Argentina

# Chardonnay Reserve, Domaine Bousquet, Tupungato, 14.5% 2021

Grapes for the reserve range are sourced their best plots with low yields. Aromas of green apples, lemon, lime, nectarines, peach, with a hint of pineapple and white flowers. Creamy on the palate with a delicious combination of vanilla and pastry. Mediumbodied, well-balanced with a persistent finish.

# Chardonnay, HdV, Hyde Vineyard, Napa Valley, 14%2016

Aromas of golden delicious apple and honeysuckle are balanced by hints of nutmeg, saline and white pepper. Subtle herbal tones of lemon that cuts through the palate. Flavours of apricot and mango round out the brighter tones of lime and other bright citrus.
